INSTALLATION OF PAX SEAT LUGGAGE RESTRAINT BAR

1. Planning Information

A. Effectivity

All aircraft fitted with the standard passenger seat.

B. Reason

As part of the ongoing development and product improvement program at PILATUS, this Service Bulletin introduces an optional luggage restraint bar for the standard passenger seat. This allows luggage to be stored under the seat.

C. Description

Accomplishment of this Service Bulletin consists of completing the following tasks:

- (1) Remove the standard passenger seats.
- (2) Install the luggage restraint bar.
- (3) Install the standard passenger seats.
